We are however, restarting 11.00am Sunday morning services at St Mark's this Sunday. Families are very welcome, please note that all children must be accompanied by an adult.



The next thing we knew, Jesus was making a whip out of cords, and he began to drive the animals out of the Temple.

The Temple was built by King Herod. It was a massive building and very important to the Jews.



Jesus was angry that people were being cheated by being made to pay lots of money for things in the temple which they were being told they needed to have to give to God. Some people were trying to get rich off God's temple - it was like they were selling God!!

Jesus was God's own son. He knew that he was going to give his life up for everybody in the world, dying on the cross and

being raised to life again was going to mean that people wouldn't need to pay for animals to get sacrificed in the temple in the future. Jesus himself would bridge the gap between people and God.

In your pack this week you will find a cross with some ribbon and a tool to scratch the cross with.




Scratch a pattern onto the specially coated surface to reveal bright rainbow colours. You can hang your cross up by the ribbon, or use it as a bookmark.



On the next page, there are some puzzles for you to do, and then a couple of colouring pages.


